

Simple Tips To Relocate A Wooden Map of World UK!

Moreover, if it makes you insecure that the beauty of the world map wooden UK will be lost or broken in the process of pulling the pieces from the wall. So read on.

Tools Necessary To Remove The World Map Wooden UK

- 1. Blow dryer
- 2. Kitchen spatula
- 3. Flat knife or paper tool

Process to remove the map is as follows:

- 1. To quickly start, first remove the small pieces by picking them—like compass, thumb—pins, and country names—from the basic map structure, which are pinned to the wood.
- 2. Now use any heating element like a blow dryer to take off the double-sided tape from the wall. Its heat will make it easier to peel off the pieces. While holding the blow dryer, try to give hot air to the end of the piece so that the tape starts to loosen up due to excess heat.

- 3. It is a long process as there are many small and large pieces to be removed. So take help from your sibling or your friend to speed it up.
- 4. Use a flat spatula or a blunt knife to remove each piece. Sneaking the spatula in between the wall and the large pieces of the adhered map lets it loosen a bit more and can finish the work faster.

Tips and tricks that will be beneficial during the entire process of removing it:

- 1. The first is to keep the original cardboard packaging of the wood 3D map. You can store all the components in it safely before taking it to your new home. It is important to keep all the tiny pieces and large ones in one place and restructure the whole design perfectly in your new home or office.
- 2. Keep the template safe so that if you are considering relocating it, you will place the whole décor in the correct measurements.
- 3. While sticking it on the wall on the first hand, take very small pieces of double-sided tape. It will make sure that the wall remains in a good condition even after removing the map and doesn't get chipped.
